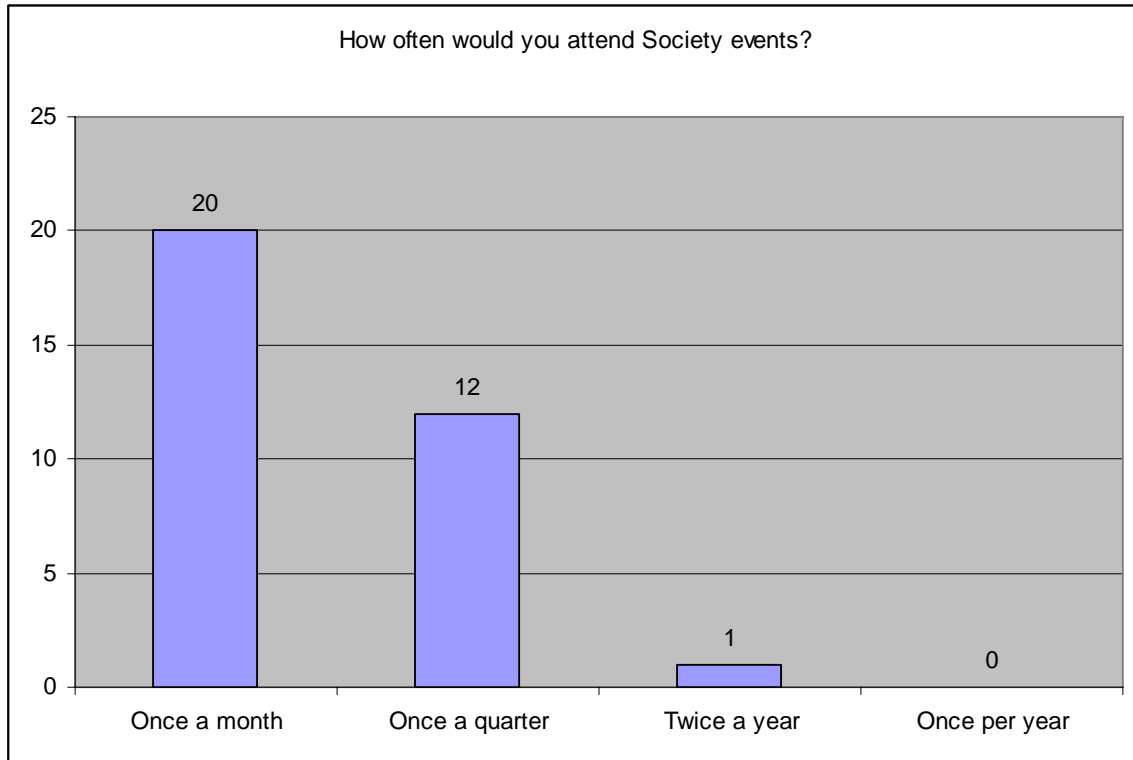


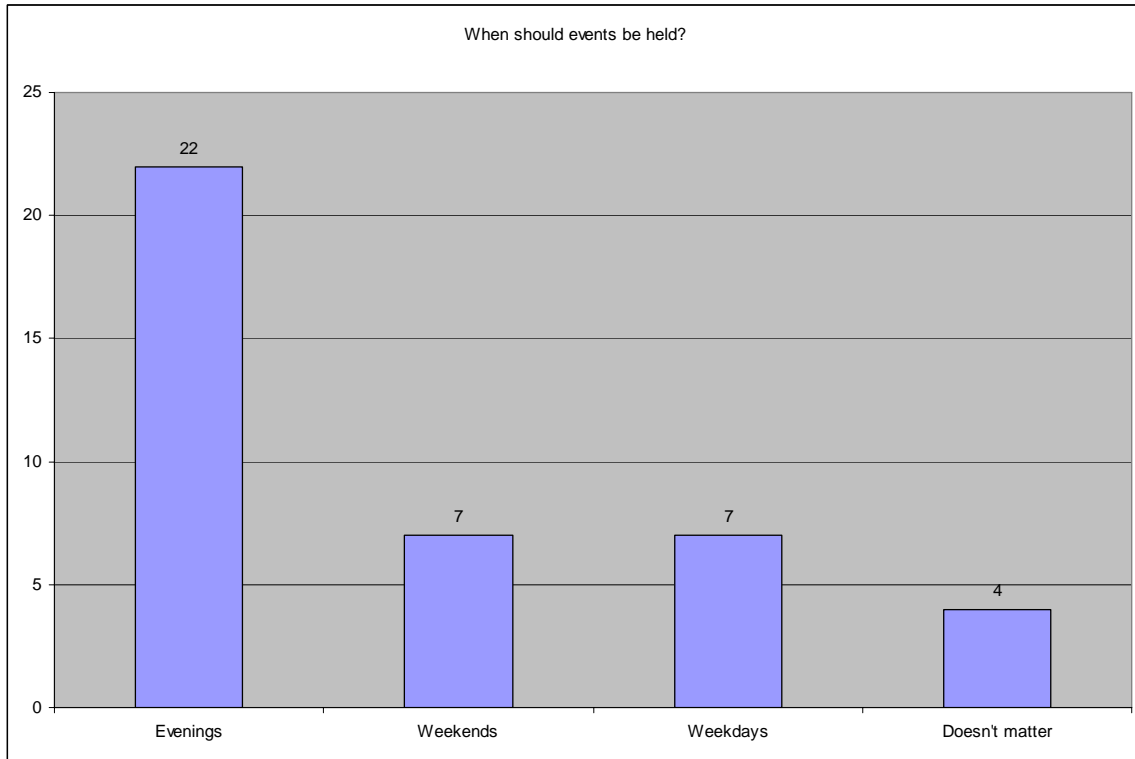

How often would you attend Society events?



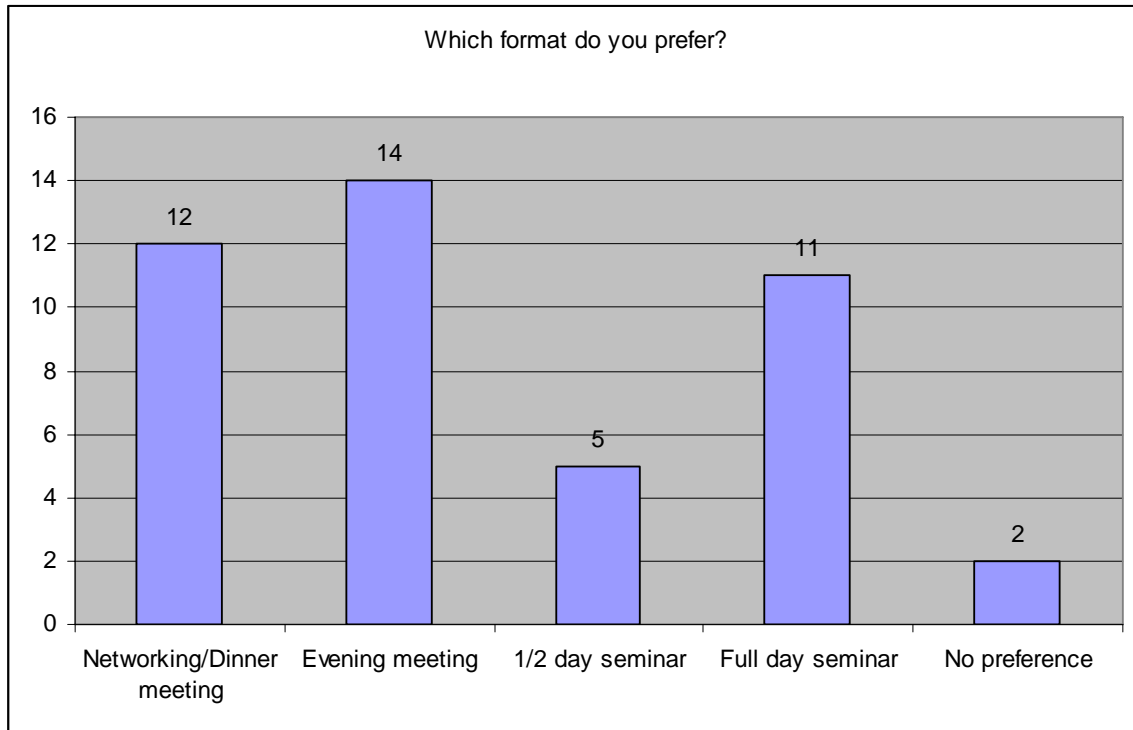

When should events be held?



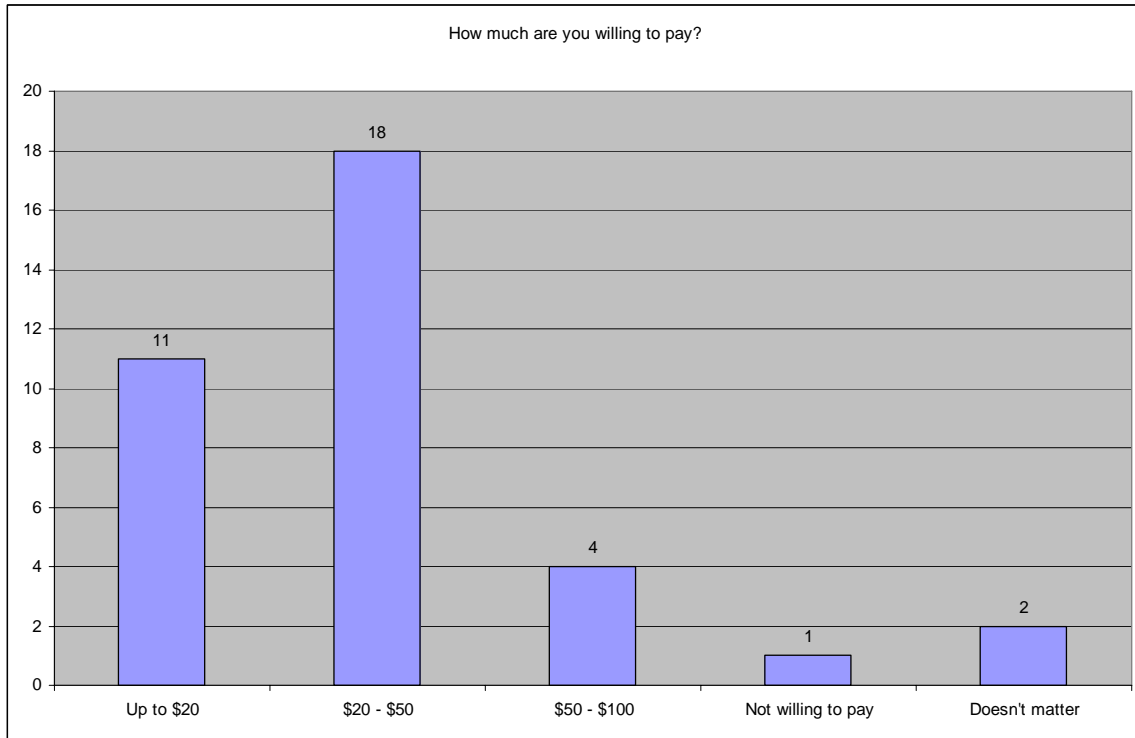

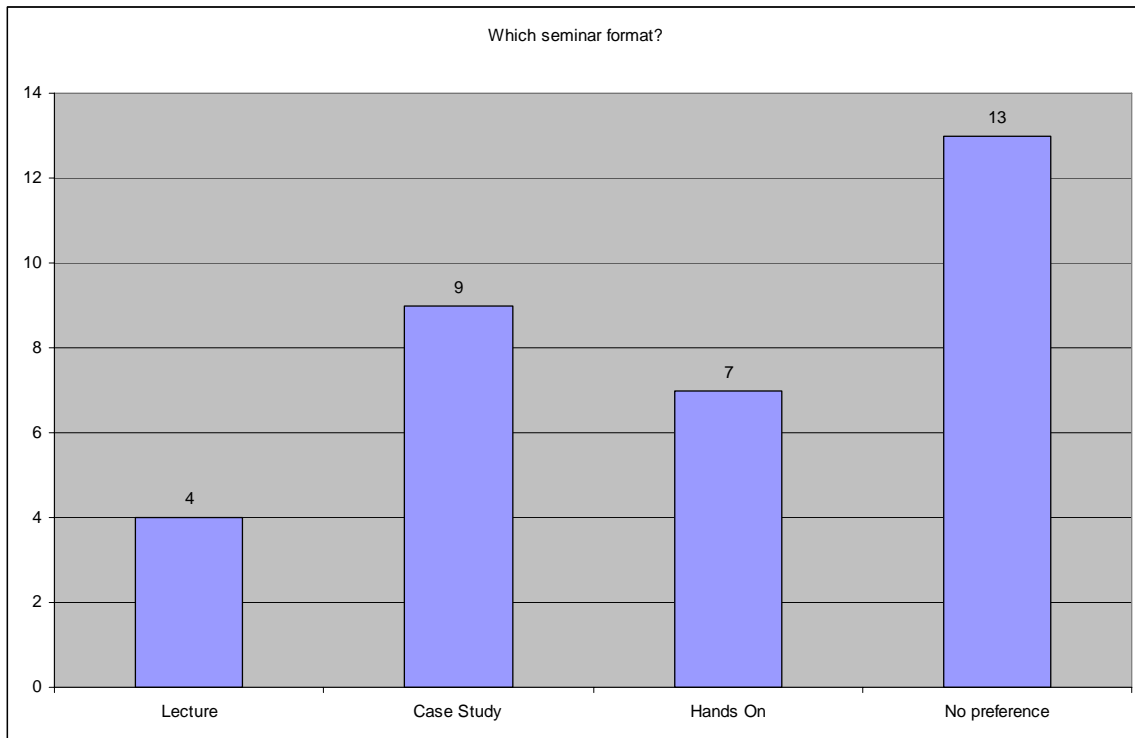

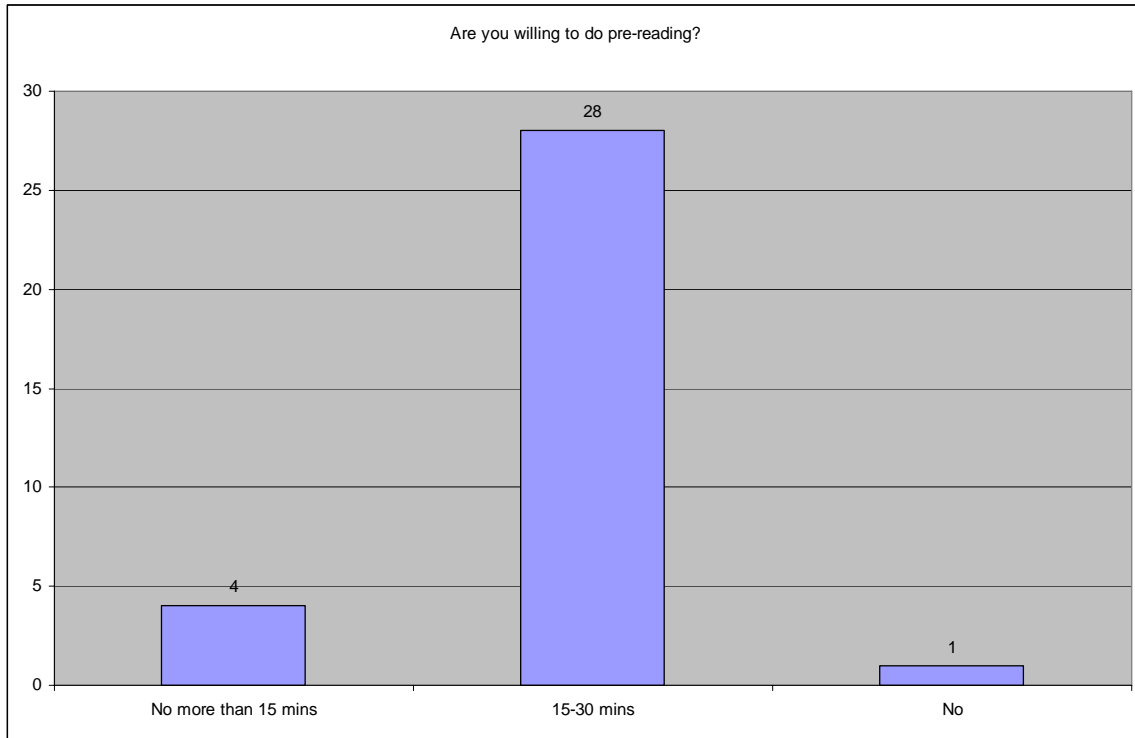
